A Lenci earthenware figure of Zizi, circa 1934, modelled after Helen König Scavini, as a young woman in a check dress wearing a red hat and scarf, a book under one arm and two dogs at her feet, raised on an oval base, original applied paper label to base 'Lenci 477 Turin Italy' with painted marks 'Lenci R Made In Italy' and 'The Mauk-Murray Studios, Inc ...' applied paper label, height 39cm (one dog re-stuck to base).

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

At some point the black and white dog has broken away from the base at its feet and has been visibly glued back into position. There are associated minor losses/chips to the base at the points where the feet are re-glued. This dog has a small glaze chip to the top of its right ear. The dog leads are missing. Otherwise the figure is in good order with no other chips, cracks or repairs.
