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A white gold, sapphire and diamond bar brooch, the centre claw set with the cushion shaped sapphire between diamond set sides, mounted with circular cut diamonds, width 5.5cm, sapphire weight approx 9.25ct, with a Liberty case.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

520. Cut: sapphire is oval faceted cut, the diamonds are old mixed cut. Colour: the sapphire is a deep blue/lilac. Clarity: some inclusions are visible in the sapphire. Carat: length 13mm, width 8.5mm, depth 7.5mm, diamonds weigh approx 0.03ct. The claws do not seem to have been interfered with which would suggest this is the original stone to the setting. The eight cut diamonds look to be fairly clear white stones. The bar of the front of the brooch is slightly bent. The brooch would benefit from careful professional cleaning. The case is badly damaged by the hinge. There is some water staining within the case however the Liberty label is perfectly clear. In overall very good condition.
