An Edwardian mahogany and satinwood crossbanded bureau bookcase by Gillows of Lancaster, bearing stamp to lock plates, the arch moulded pediment above a pair of astragal glazed doors, the fall front above two short and two long drawers, on a plinth base, height 187cm, width 96cm, depth 53cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

2004. General overall condition is good throughout with some fairly minor faults commensurate with its age throughout. The fall flap has two very thin cracks to the surface of the veneer and the base as a whole has some minor scuffs and scratches to the corners and edges. The hinges appear to have been replaced and moved at some stage, but looks professionally done, with a visible let-in where the old hinges have been. Writing surface worn and scuffs to interior.
