A Staffordshire pottery cow creamer and cover, mid/late 19th century, polychrome enamelled with flowers standing on an oval base with large moulded central flower and yellow and red detail, height 13cm (minor faults), together with a Staffordshire pottery figure of Mother Goose.

Condition Report

1416. Cow - overall fine crazing to glaze, some chipping to base edge. Starcrack to belly of cow. Glued repair to left ear. Cover a little discoloured. Mother Goose - minute glaze nick to tip of shawl at back of figure, otherwise in good condition.
