A Chinese iron red and gilt porcelain tripod censer and two-section cover, mark of Qianlong but probably Republic period, the cylindrical body moulded in relief with panels of archaistic scroll motifs on a duck-egg blue ground, the cover with similarly pierced decoration, iron red and gilt pseudo seal mark to base, diameter 26cm (upper section of cover badly damaged).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1080. Top pierced cover broken into a number of pieces, most pieces present but unable to tell exactly what is missing as there are a number of small fragments and breaks. Middle section with minute blemish to inner rim edge. Pierced sections with smoke grime. Otherwise, typical wear to enamel and gilding.
