

(Minor spotting to first and last few pages and fore-edge.) Contemporary green half-morocco, spine gilt in six compartments with raised bands, lettered in the second, the others with repeat decoration in gilt, g.e. (spine slightly faded, extremities scuffed).

Condition Report

3099. There is some spotting to the blank preliminaries, only very lightly to the frontispiece and title page. There are no inscriptions, no spotting to the plates, some spotting to the gilt fore-edge. Hinges are firm, endpapers well preserved, rubbing to extremities and to the raised bands.
