A Royal Crown Derby Imari pattern coffee cup and saucer, circa 1909, pattern number '3788', height 5.5cm, a Coalport green ground cabinet cup and saucer with floral panels, three gilt-lined Royal Worcester cabinet cups and saucers, and a mixed group of other English and European cabinet cups and saucers and decorative ceramics, including a Dresden shell shaped dish.

Condition Report

1490. Generally the lot is in good order. There are insignificant issues overall: Green ground Coalport cup and saucer - both crazed but ok. Worcester Imari cup - crazed but ok. Meissen style cup - decorated over minor manufacturers nick to rim. Dresden miniature plate - starcrack to base. Worcester cup commemorating Edward VII - very light staining to rim and crazing, otherwise ok. Dresden cup with high scroll handle - nibbled chipping to edge of foot. Black ground Worcester cup and saucer - minor scratches to saucer, minor firing fault to rim of cup by handle. Yellow ground Worcester cup & saucer - both crazed but ok.
