434. Overall good condition, if a little dirty and dusty. Would benefit from a clean. Plate mounts are a little dull in colour but otherwise in working order with key. Coromandel in good order and frame is sound. All three glass decanters in good condition with no significant damage. One stopper has been broken in half and glued back together, other two stoppers in good order.
