A late George III satinwood demi-lune cabinet with overall tulipwood crossbanding within ebony and boxwood stringing, the top with a painted border of foliate scrolls, the single door and side panels with oval figured reserves within painted bead borders, raised on tapering block legs with spade feet, height 93cm, width 113cm, depth 55cm.

Estimate: £3,500 - £4,500

Condition Report

2084. At present the cabinet is locked and we do not have a key to open it, therefore interior is un-inspected. The top has some light surface scratches and marks but generally is in good condition and has a nice patina. The base is also in good condition but doesn't seem to have the same richness in colour. Having inspected closely, perhaps the base section is a little later made than the top, as there is no stringing and no repeated painted motifs. The back and base panels look ok but feel as if they have been 'aged'.
