A large Haviland & Co. Limoges Céramique Impressioniste Barbotine French pottery vase, circa 1880, the flattened circular body probably painted by Madame Marie Bracquemond, indistinctly signed, with a head and shoulders portrait of a young woman surrounded by foliage, the reverse with mottled cream and brown tones, impressed 'Haviland & Co. Limoges' to base with numerals '45 2', height 36cm (some faults).

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

4122. The rear edge of the rim has a chipped crack running down into the body and around the neck in both directions, both cracks also running down into the rear side of the body. There are areas of loss to the glazing on the corners of the body, mainly on the rear side. The footrim has a substantial chip to one corner and some more minor chipping to the edges. Overall surface crazing.
