A Nailsea glass bellows vase, 19th century, the gimmel flask with white combed decoration and applied trailed detail flanking a fleur-de-lis, raised on a knopped stem and circular foot, height 35cm, together with a similar smaller Nailsea glass gimmel flask in the form of a pair of bellows and a glass flask in the form of a pistol (minor faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1453. Bellows vase - glued repair to one handle of bellows, minor manufacturing flaw to body. Bellows flask - small chip to top edge and trailed detail with chip and loss. Pistol - small chips and losses to detail.
