## Condition Report

1494. Cupid - some minor haircracks visible to body by left arm. Otherwise ok. Very minor wear to gilt detail. Maiden - small chip to left big toe. Some craze lines to body. Missing end of bow. Broken at neck and visibly glued. Very light wear to gilding.
