A Copeland & Garratt Late Spode Camilla pattern blue printed footbath, circa 1834, of typical oval baluster shape, blue printed and impressed marks to base, length 56cm, together with an early 20th century Mason's blue printed wash bowl and jug.

Condition Report

1525. Footbath - fundamentally in good condition, but under close inspection there is a narrow chip approx 1.5cm in length to underside rim edge, minor typical flaking/glaze losses to rim, a hairline crack running horizontally under one handle and typical wear to base interior. Jug - the print is a little blurry but otherwise in good condition, no chip, cracks or repairs. Bowl - two minor star cracks and crazing to base. Light surface wear to the transfer decoration, otherwise in good condition.
