A mixed group of mostly English porcelain, 19th century, including a pair of miniature blue ground bottle vases, possibly Coalport, height 6cm, a green ground inkstand, a Minton 'Buckingham Palace' saucer with Victoria monogram and a Daniel coffee cup with floral feet (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1471. Daniel cup - faint hairline visible to underside, otherwise ok, no mark. Pair blue ground miniature vases - minute nicks to rims. Similar floral miniature vase - neck cracked and restored. Wedgwood vesta holder and miniature tyg - both ok. Mintons miniature saucer - crazed but ok. Floral miniature saucer - crazed, chip to underside rim edge. Inkstand - broken in half and visibly restored, cracks and chips to matching items. Buckingham Palace saucer - gilt rim worn. Nine saucers - generally ok with some wear, one with hairline. Bute cup - cracked and chipped. Limoges can and saucer - ok. Five plates - one cracked and crazed, one chipped and crazed, one with light wear, one crazed but ok.
