An English porcelain part service, circa 1820, Daniel type, with gilt overlaid cobalt blue decoration, comprising two cake plates, a slop bowl, six coffee cups, six teacups and six saucers, unmarked (some restoration), together with another English porcelain part service, mid-19th century, red painted pattern No. '249' to bases (faults).

Condition Report

1487. Daniel type - gilding strong and bright overall as no real wear. Two cake plates - one heavily restored, other ok. Slop - ok. 6 coffee cups - one with glued handle, otherwise ok. 6 teacups - 2 with faint hairlines, otherwise ok. 6 saucers - all ok. Other service - crazed overall. Teapot and cover - 2 minor haircracks to flange. Sucrier & cover - crack to body, one handle and cover. Slop - ok. Jug - minor haircrack to rim. 2 cake plates - light wear, generally ok. 6 cups - one cracked, 2 with light staining. 6 saucers - ok. 5 tea plates - one stained, others ok.
