A pair of English porcelain recumbent greyhounds, mid-19th century, each modelled on a rectangular claret cushion base with gilt edges and tassels, length 12.7cm. Note: this model of greyhounds is mentioned in 'English Porcelain Animals of the 19th Century', by D.G. Rice, p.57 (restored).

Condition Report

1410. Head up - base probably broken in half width ways through middle of dog and professionally but visibly restored due to colour differences, lack of visible crazing and some peeling to spraying on claret ground. Associated restoration to majority of dog's body. Scratching head - left hind leg visibly restored due to colour difference with associated colour difference to inner left side of dog where overspraying has occurred.
