A silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with cylinder escapement, red gem set end stone and scroll pierced balance cock, the backplate detailed 'Ellicott, London 7622', with a signed and numbered gilt metal dust cover, the enamelled dial with black numerals, gilt hands and centre stop seconds, the later inner and outer case London 1822, outer case diameter 5cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1080. Case is later than the movement. Outer case in generally good condition, few minor dents and typical light surface scratches. Hinge is good and closes nice and tight. Inner case is in similar condition, hinge appears to have had a solder repair to interior. Dial is in good clean condition. Dust cover in good condition and movement is clean but not in working order.
