An early 20th century mahogany cased Vienna style wall clock with eight day weight driven movement striking on a gong, the two-piece enamel dial with black Roman numerals, the case with domed top above glazed door and sides, height 84cm, with two brass weights and mercury compensated pendulum.

Condition Report

1142. This clock appears to be complete and all parts seem to be as originally manufactured. It is not a marriage. There is some very minor cracking to the dial (hardly noticeable). The pendulum consists of four tubes of mercury. One mercury tube is empty. The other mercury is present but is very dirty. Very minor dents to the brass weights. Complete with original winding key.
