A large Italian maiolica oyster dish, late 19th/early 20th century, of circular shape with central armorial decoration, surrounded by twenty-four shell depressions and a raised edge, supported on a circular foot, unmarked, diameter 45.5cm (minor faults).

1425.6.5cm hairline crack to rim. 1.5cm \times 1cm chip to rim and 4cm hairline crack running down from this. Numerous small chips to rim, but no significant damage, colours are nice and bright.
