A late 19th century gilt brass pocket barometer, matching compass and thermometer set by Negretti & Zambra, the signed silvered barometer dial numbered '14073', the signed mother-of-pearl compass dial with black detail, within a fitted leather case, the hinged lid interior inset with the signed mercury thermometer, total length 13cm.

Condition Report

1210. Barometer is working. Minor wear/discolouration to gilt case, particularly suspension loop. Dial in good order, only very minor discolouration to edges. Compass appears to be working. Case in generally good condition, small patch of 'rubbed down' wear to back of case (approx 0.7cm x 0.5cm). Leather case is worn inside and out.
