## Condition Report

1531. Green jar - 2 tiny chips to edge of stand, otherwise ok but gilding to edge of cover and stand totally worn. Pair vases - in good condition. Jar & cover - small chip to top rim exterior edge of vase. Minute nick to inner edge of cover. Wear to gilding of foot which there has been an attempt to disguise.
