## LOT 1016

A Japanese silver wire inlaid cloisonné vase by Hayashi Kodenji, Meiji period, of shouldered tapering form, finely worked with sparrows flying and perched amidst bamboo, above chrysanthemums on a midnight blue ground, the neck and footrim decorated with white and yellow flowerheads on a cloud scroll ground, stamped mark to base, height 18cm (restoration).

## **Condition Report**

1016. This vase has been restored, which has left a rather matt finish. There is also a 'bubbly' area on the shoulder above the bamboo and a vertical repair/restoration from the foot upwards (5cm high x 1.5cm wide). Good clear mark to base.
