A Japanese silver wire inlaid cloisonné vase, Meiji period, of slender baluster form, finely worked with sparrows flying about bamboo on a midnight blue ground, the brown ground collar and foot filled with flowerheads and red scrolling foliage, unsigned, height 18.5cm (hairline to back of vase).

Condition Report

1018. 4.5cm x 4cm verical hairline cracks to back of vase and a hairline crack which runs around the foot of the vase just above the different colour foot. Tiny bubble speck near base of vase. Otherwise the vase is in fairly good order with no significant damage or repairs.
