A Japanese lacquer two-case inro, Meiji period, of flattened oval form, decorated in gilt with an eagle perched on a pine branch, against a speckled iron red/brown ground, unsigned, length 7cm.

Condition Report

1255. Fairly poor condition, but no repairs. Decoration in generally good order. Top section has few small dents and some typical wear. Centre section side loop is detached and connected to the cord, also some typical wear. Lower section has a small horizontal split to the lacquer and the inner sleeve has broken off and is stuck in the middle section.
