A small group of Chinese porcelain, late 19th century and later, comprising a trefoil bowl, painted with red capped cranes on a blue ground, width 16.5cm, pair of blue and white vases and covers, height 16.5cm, a cylindrical vase, painted with birds, flowers and lines of text, height 19.5cm, and a blue and white jug and cover (cover repaired).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1129. Bowl - small chip to exterior rim edge and 1.5cm long vertical haircrack to rim. Pair vases - first with glued repair or associated haircrack to neck and minor frit to foot. Second with vertical crack to neck and frit to foot. One cover restored, other with minor frit. Cylindrical vase - ok, no chips, cracks or repairs. Jug & cover - jug ok. Cover broken into many pieces and visibly glued with minor losses.
