## Condition Report

387. Chester frame - silver is in good order overall with nice clear hallmarks. There is a small split to one cherub's head. The hallmarks are nice and clear. The velvet is pretty much totally worn. Birmingham 1900 - few small dents, couple of pin holes. Nice clear hallmarks. Replacement strut to reverse. Velvet almost totally worn. Birmingham 1899 - silver in good order. Nice clear hallmarks. Typical wear to leather.
