An English porcelain miniature jug, circa 1830, of octagonal shape enamelled with flowers and gilt with foliage, unmarked, height 3.3cm, together with three similar teacups with high scroll handles and four saucers, and another miniature part service.

## Condition Report

1402. Miniature jug - some wear to gilding on high points and some small areas of crazing, otherwise ok. Four saucers - some light wear to the high points, otherwise all ok. Three cups - the handle of one cup has a small but noticeable area of gilding loss/flaking which leaves a rough textured area. Otherwise all ok. Other miniature part service - all generally ok, apart from some losses to the painted floral decoration, most noticeable on the coffee pot and saucers.
