An Edwardian silver novelty pin cushion in the form of a cradle, the raised hood fitted for a thimble, on ball feet, Birmingham 1909 by Adie & Lovekin Ltd, length 6.3cm, a silver novelty pin cushion in the form of a square cushion with beaded edge and fleur-de-lis corners, Birmingham 1908 by A & J Zimmerman Ltd, width 6cm, and a silver novelty pin cushion in the form of a trough, raised on wirework legs, London 1845, height 3.5cm.

Condition Report

366. Cradle - good condition, couple of minor dents but nothing too significant. Marks good and clear, maker's mark slightly rubbed.
Cushion - good condition, typical minor dents to top and typical light surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks. No significant damage or repairs.
Small trough - misshapen and dented sides, and could well have been made up from something else.
