Two ormolu mounted Meissen porcelain parrots, second half 19th century, each perched on a treestump and rocky base, one base applied with foliage, the ormolu mounts with foliate scroll detail, crossed swords in underglaze blue to bases, both incised 'Z49', height 32cm. Note: two similar parrots, lacking the ormolu mounts, were sold at Bonhams, London, 14th June 2017, Lot 225.

Estimate: £1,200 - £1,600

Condition Report

1410. Bird with yellow head - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs. Bird with blue/green head - losses to applied foliage on base. Tiny scratch to top of beak which is pinhead sized and inconsequential. Otherwise in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.
