An early 19th century Continental gold mounted and gem set amethyst quartz scent bottle of diminutive pear shaped form, the body set with a rose diamond and emerald flower spray, the two-colour gold collar and hinge lid with foliate banded decoration, unmarked, height 4.9cm (stopper damaged).

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

2480. The stopper end is stuck in the bottle neck. The amethyst body appears to be in good condition. There is a small residue of what looks like dirt or glue around the rear edge of the lid. No assay marks on it but would assume it is fairly high carat gold.

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
