A silver mounted cameo glass scent bottle and screw cover, dated 1905, in the manner of Thomas Webb, the yellow body of teardrop shape, overlaid in white and carved with hydrangeas, Birmingham hallmarks by T.W. & S., length 10cm.

Condition Report

1614. In good condition overall. There are some typical minor manufacturers blemishes to the carved detail, fairly inconsequential. The bottom tip has not been ground but has a pinhead nick. The screw cover and collar are in good order and seem to be original, there is some filling to the inside edge of the collar which doesn't seem to cover damage but is because it is quite a lengthy mount. Missing stopper. Nice clear hallmarks.
