A pair of Derby porcelain cabinet plates, circa 1825, each centrally painted in the manner of Steele with a still life basket of fruit within a gilt scroll and foliate border, iron red painted marks to bases, diameter 22.2cm. Provenance: from the estate of the late John Young (1927-2017).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1500. Plate one - long hairline crack running from the top rim edge diagonally left towards the centre of the plate, not reaching as far as the central painted panel. Light crazing to one side of plate and some rubbing to gilding on the rim. Plate two - in generally good condition. Overall crazing which is slightly darker in appearance on the reverse near the rim edge. Otherwise no chips, cracks or repairs.
