A Chinese export soft paste porcelain vase, Qianlong period, the pear form body applied with flowers and leaves to the neck, height 18cm, together with a small collection of other Chinese export porcelain, 18th century, comprising a famille rose reticulated tea bowl, diameter 9.1cm, a famille rose coffee cup and two saucers with gilt and en grisalle borders and a pair of famille rose saucers (faults).

1015. Vase - indistinct starcrack to neck with some faint associated craze lines to body. Number of losses to applied detail. Tea bowl - visibly repaired section to rim with haircrack. Gilt rim worn. Cup - cracked and chipped. Gilding rubbed. Saucers - each have faults/repairs.
