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An impressive Japanese silk embroidered tapestry wall hanging, early 20th century, finely worked in coloured threads with temples, pavilions and bridges in a forested river landscape, heading to a further shore, under the skyline of a snow-capped Mount Fuji, 225cm x 149cm, with a patterned silk brocade border and backing.

Condition Report

1080. In good condition overall for its age and size. No significant damage, repairs, faults or losses. It does not seem to be faded, but if it is then any fading is uniform overall. There are a few tiny loose threads to the bottom left amidst the iris and crease lines where it has obviously been folded for some time. The backing fabric has some minor pulling/thinning where the seams join, but is overall in good order.

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
