A scarce 1873 pattern U.S. trowel socket bayonet with broad double edged blade, length 25.5cm, with central spine and blued socket, struck 'PAT. APR. 16472', in its brass mounted black leather sheath with integral frog with brass U.S. stud.

Estimate: £100 - £150

## **Condition Report**

773. Rust to the surface of the bayonet along the length of the spine and some other minor surface oxidization. Some surface cracking to the sheath and typical surface wear, also some greening to the brassware. The rotating socket seems to function very well and it fits into the sheath very well too.
