A George III mahogany chest of two short and three long graduated drawers, fitted with a brushing slide and with carved blind fretwork corners, raised on ogee bracket feet, height 90cm, width 97cm, depth 52cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2010. Some repairs to the veneers on the corners of the top and just a few minor surface cracks to the veneer. One strip of cock beading missing on side of first long drawer, a few other chips and repairs of veneer around the drawers, on the carcass front. Two small pieces of blind fretwork missing on corners. Some surface staining to the front of the chest and overall minor scuffs and scratches. The oak drawer linings have pine bases running side to side. The handles and escutcheons are later replacements. Locks appear to be original.
