A Keswick School of Industrial Arts copper vase of flared cylindrical form, worked with a band of stylized flowers and leaves, bearing 'KSIA' mark to base, height 25cm, together with two other similar vases, one unmarked, heights 19.3cm and 18cm.

Condition Report

4055. The larger vase has a dent to one of the flowerheads and some other more minor dents, scuffs and scratches. The circular vase has some dents and misshaping to the rim and a minor dent to the footrim. The other vase has misshapen sides to four of the rim sides and quite an indented side to the foot.
