Two Royal Copenhagen porcelain Flora Danica pattern plates, circa 1969-74, one painted with a titled study 'Myosotis stricta Link', the other with 'Lotus corniculatus L', within a gilt enriched serrated edge rim with pink and gilt rectangular panels, painted marks to bases, diameter 22.2cm (faults and restoration).

1402. One plate has an area of restoration to the rim, approx 5cm in length and an associated hairline crack to the body. The other plate has a faint hairline crack to the rim. Otherwise ok.
