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A George III and later mahogany cased circular wall clock with brass twin fusee movement striking on a bell, the brass dial with black Roman hours and outer Arabic minutes, framing a silvered date aperture and inscribed 'Edwd Tutet Fenchurch Street London' within a moulded circular surround, diameter 45cm, with a pendulum (faults and restoration).

Condition Report

1115. Mahogany bezel is split in numerous places and repaired with metal plates to back. Mahogany surround also has a split. Box behind is missing its trap door and has an aperture cut into the side to allow the bell strike to fit. Also a filled-in hole to side of case. Unusual rotating peg fitting. Movement looks intact but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
