A Japanese Kutani vase, Meiji period, painted with panels of Buddhist lion, peacock, butterfly and flowers beneath figural and landscape roundels, height 28cm, together with a Japanese Satsuma earthenware koro and cover, Meiji period, with butterfly moulded handles, height 42cm, and a Japanese earthenware vase, early 20th century, painted with figures, height 31cm.

Condition Report

1114. Kutani - overall fine lightly stained crazing to glaze. Firing crack to footrim, otherwise in good condition overall. Red painted mark to base. Koro - fine crazing to glaze overall. Cover cracked with finial missing one leg and glued repair to other. 2 small haircracks to rim of main body, otherwise ok. No marks. Vase - fine stained crazing overall, otherwise ok. No marks.
