A Chinese pale celadon jade two section belt buckle, probably Qing dynasty, each piece carved and pierced in relief with a crouching chilong grasping a lingzhi stem in its mouth, one with chilong-head hook, the other with pierced loop, total length 11.5cm.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1014. Good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Few internal hairline inclusions to the stone which you can see on the back of the chilong on the hook side off the buckle.

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
