A George III oak longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the brass break arch dial with silvered chapter ring framing a matt centre with silvered subsidiary seconds and date aperture, all beneath a silvered boss inscribed 'Thos Dible X Church Hants', the hood with moulded arch pediment, turned columns and glazed door, the trunk with crossbanded rectangular door, above a plain base and bracket feet, height 211cm, with pendulum, two weights and winder.

1171. In generally good clean condition. No significant damage. Base has a vertical split and has probably been altered at some stage. Movement appears to all be present and in generally good order. Dial also in good order.
