A 19th century French brass and red tortoiseshell boule cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the brass dial with inset enamel hour plaques and outer engraved Arabic minutes, the case with Cupid surmount and inlaid bird and foliate scroll decoration, glazed front door and side panels, on a rectangular base and toupie feet, height 49cm, with sunburst mask pendulum.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1155. Generally good condition. No significant damage or repairs. Glass door and sides in good order. Small enamel panel below hour numerals has a hairline and chip to edge. Few tiny nicks to tortoiseshell on corners, but otherwise tortoiseshell and metalwork in good order.

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
