A Chinese famille rose export porcelain garniture of five vases, Qianlong period, comprising three baluster vases and domed covers and a pair of flared beaker vases, each piece finely enamelled with two cockerels, rocks, peonies and blossoming branches beneath a pink ground collar, heights ranging from 22.5cm to 29cm. Note: a similar garniture is illustrated by Williamson and Tuttle in 'The Book of Famille Rose', 1970, plate LIII.

Condition Report

4050. Both beaker vases in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light wear to enamels around rims, otherwise enamels are good, fresh and vibrant.

All three baluster vases in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light surface wear to enamels and minor typical surface scratches to glaze.

All three covers in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.
