Condition Report

4060. Wine cup and 2 saucers - wine cup good condition with no cracks or repairs, minor chips to footrim. Both matching saucers with hairlines to rim, one 2cm, the other 1.7cm.

Cup and saucer painted with flautist - cup with 2cm hairline crack and tiny rim chips, saucer with minor rim chips.

Pair saucers with figures and gilt ground - one with 1cm hairline crack to rim, both with minor rim chips.

Saucer with cat and rabbit - minor rim chips, no cracks or repairs.

Hexagonal cup - chips to rim, bruised hairline crack to base.

Pink cell ground cup - 3.4cm hairline to rim.

Pair pink ground flared cups - good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Gilt ground floral cup - good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Black and gilt rimmed cup - minor rim chips, otherwise in good condition.

Pink cell diaper ground cup - broken in half and repaired with rim chips.

Flared floral cup - good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Black and gilt cockerel teabowl - minor rim chips otherwise in good condition.

Teabowl with two deer - 0.5cm by 0.2cm chip to rim and another smaller, otherwise ok.

Black and gilt chrysanthemum teabowl - 1.3cm hairline to rim, otherwise ok.

Flower spray teabowl - 2cm hairline and minor rim restoration.

Iron red and gilt key fret rim teabowl - tiny chip to rim, otherwise in good condition.

Floral panelled teabowl - small chip to rim, otherwise in good condition.

Vertical arched panel teabowl - minor chips to rim, otherwise in good condition.

Flowerhead form saucer - good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Fruit spray saucer - 1.7 and 0.8cm hairlines to rim.

Largest saucer - small chip to rim, otherwise ok.

Buddha's hand citron saucer - minor rim chips, otherwise ok.

Pair bird and branch saucers - one with 0.5cm hairline and rim chip, other with tiny rim chips.

Floral sprays saucer - minor rim chips.

Pendent border saucer - minor rim chip, otherwise ok.

Fenced garden saucer - good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Floral groups saucer - good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.
