LOT 4130

A Chinese famille rose enameled export porcelain part service, late Qianlong period, comprising seven teabowls, two tea cups, coffee cup, twenty saucers, seven larger saucers, five saucer dishes, trembleuse cup, nine stands and spoon tray, each finely enameled with a design of birds and blossoming branches, diameter of saucer dish 15.8cm (some faults).

Condition Report

4130. Overall the enamels are in good condition with nice vibrant and fresh colours.

7 teabowls - 6 with hairline cracks and minor rim chips, 1 with minor rim chips.

2 tea cups - both with hairline cracks to rim, one with chip to rim and footrim.

Coffee cup - hairline crack to rim.

20 saucers - 12.5cm diameter, 6 in very good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. 2 in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration but some wear to gilt on rims. 2 with star hairline cracks to bases and wear to gilt rims. 10 with small rim chips, varying degrees of wear too gilt rims.

7 larger saucers - approx 13.9cm diameter, each with varying star hairlines to bases, minor rim chips and almost complete wear to gilding on rims.

5 saucer dishes - approx 15.9cm diameter, 2 in good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration, 3 with faint starcracks to bases, otherwise good.

trembleuse cup - approx 6cm hairline to rim, otherwise good.

9 stands - 3 in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration, 6 with minor rim chips otherwise in good condition.

spoon tray - in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.
