An Italian maiolica jug of Cantagalli type, 19th century, typically painted with grotesques and scrollwork beneath a mask spout and bifurcated handle, 'William Ridout Collection' paper label to base, height 17cm (faults and repairs), together with a floral painted Delft plate and pair of plates with gilt enriched chinoiserie floral decoration (minor faults).

Condition Report

4195. Jug - approx 4cm long by 1cm deep filled and restored section to foot, approx 6cm long by 1.5cm deep restored break to rim above handle including associated stapled and restored repairs to upper and lower handle terminals with repainting, from the break emanates a horizontal crack which leads to another 3.5cm long chip to the rim and other smaller fritted chips to the rim, repainted restoration to top edge of spout.

Floral plate - typical fritted chipping to rim, light surface scratches.

Pair plates - both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, one with minor surface scratches to central decoration.
