A set of twelve English Bristol green glass wines, early 19th century, each roundel bowl raised on a plain cylindrical stem applied with three raspberry prunts above a reeded spreading circular foot, height 12cm, together with a set of eight cut glass wines with pale green tinted bowls and hexagonal stems, four similar clear wines and five matching clear sherry glasses (some faults).

### Condition Report

4215. Bristol Green - 6 in good condition, 1 with numerous bad chips to foot, 2 with one small chip to edge of foot, 2 with tiny nicks to edge of foot, 1 with minute nick to underside edge of foot and abrasion to top end of trailing on foot.

Pale Green - 6 ok, 1 with possible minor polishing to edge of foot and tiny nick to bowl, 1 with small chip to rim of bowl.

Clear wines - 3 good, chip to knop of one.

Clear Sherry - 2 ok, 3 with chips to rim.
