A late 19th century Dutch silver oval two-handled bonbon basket, the sides pierced and engraved with flowers and leaves flanked by two naturalistic foliate handles, raised on foliate feet, Rotterdam 1899, maker's mark AH, length 21.5cm.

Condition Report

303. There is a small round spot visible on the underside of the basket which under magnification reveals a solder hole. Otherwise the basket is in good condition with no damage or repairs to pierced work. Engraving is also good and casting is crisp. No splits or repairs to pierced work. Weight 252g.
