A collection of assorted Oriental works of art, 19th century and later, including a pair of Chinese soapstone Buddhistic lions, height 16.5cm, a soapstone figure of a fisherman, Chinese and Japanese cloisonné items and two Chinese green hardstone carvings.

## Condition Report

1087. Soapstone figure - generally good condition, some minor chips.  
 Pair of soapstone lions - numerous minor chips throughout, otherwise ok.  
 Small cloisonne vase - cracked and discoloured.  
 Chinese rectangular enamel and brass box - good condition, a bit dirty.  
 Japanese cloisonne box - good condition, a bit dirty.  
 Japanese metal mini teapot - generally good condition, but some wear and scuffs to edges.  
 Chinese green circular box - dent and minor losses to side, otherwise good.  
 Chinese black cloisonne cup - some losses to enamel inside and out and misshapen footrim.  
 Japanese paperknife - handle loose, dirty and worn.  
 Chinese turquoise cloisonne bowl - small area of loss chip to side, otherwise good.  
 2 lacquer bowls - good condition.  
 Green hardstone pot and cover - minor chips, otherwise good and wood stand good.  
 Chinese carving - bird has been broken off and re-glued and a loss to stem hanging around maiden's neck.
